

Bye-Law No. 6

Examinations and Other Assessments

1. The Academic Board shall make regulations whereby arrangements shall be approved for examinations, tests and other forms of assessment, as appropriate, for courses of study and programmes of supervised research leading to the award of a degree, diploma or certificate of the University.
2. The Academic Board shall make regulations whereby the standards to be attained in such examinations, tests and other forms of assessment for the award of a degree, diploma or certificate, as the case may be, shall be prescribed.
3. The Academic Board shall make regulations laying down the procedure for assessing the class or division in the final examination, test or other assessment for the award of a degree.
4. The Academic Board shall make regulations prescribing the manner in which examinations, tests and other forms of assessment prescribed or approved by the University are to be conducted. Failure on the part of a candidate to comply with these regulations may be regarded as a disciplinary offence and dealt with as such by the University.
5. A candidate who has not:
 - (a) satisfied the requirements laid down in the bye-laws and regulations of the University or been exempted from any requirements with the approval of the Academic Board; and
 - (b) paid or caused to be paid in full all fees prescribed and any other sums due to the University;may not be admitted to an examination, test or other form of assessment.
6. The Academic Board shall make regulations prescribing the procedures for the appointment, duties, responsibilities, and tenure of office of internal and external examiners (including moderators and assessors), as appropriate.
7. The Academic Board shall make recommendations to the Board of Governors on the remuneration of external examiners.
8. The Academic Board shall make regulations prescribing the membership, terms of reference, and procedures of such awards or examinations, boards or committees as the Academic Board may

deem appropriate for courses of study and programmes of supervised research leading to degrees, diplomas and certificates of the University.

9. The Academic Board shall make regulations specifying the arrangements for the recording, reporting and publication of the results of the examinations, tests and other forms of assessment prescribed or approved by the Academic Board, and for the making, recording and reporting of the recommendations made by or on behalf of the Academic Board for the conferment of academic awards.
10. The Regulations made by the Academic Board in accordance with this bye-law shall be made after consultation with the Board of Governors.
