

BYE-LAW NO. 2

THE REPRESENTATION OF STUDENT CONCERNS

1. Registered students of the University of Wolverhampton shall have the right of representation on the Academic Board and on Committees of the Academic Board, including Course Committees, in accordance with the arrangements made by the Board of Governors and by the Academic Board respectively, and shall have the right to submit through their representative, for consideration by the Academic Board and by the Committees of the Board, as appropriate, proposals, reports and requests on all academic and related issues of proper concern to the students.
2. Representation of the student body on the Board of Governors shall be by the President of the Students' Union as a member of the Board of Governors ex officio.
3. Representation of students' interests may be made to the Vice-Chancellor of The University of Wolverhampton by the Sabbatical Officers of the Students' Union or by a resolution of a General Meeting of the Students' Union.
