

IDENTITY CARDS

The University has a policy of open access, which means that all members of the University and legitimate visitors are always encouraged to make full and proper use of the facilities on offer. Unfortunately, however, the University of Wolverhampton, like many other institutions, has experienced the presence of ‘visitors’ who have abused this open access policy by causing damage and occasional losses of property belonging to the University and its members.

For this reason, the University has an Identity Card scheme and requires all members of the University to wear an Identity Card at all times whilst on University premises. Visitors are required to register at Reception points and will be issued with a Visitors badge. University security staff will conduct frequent checks and anyone not carrying a valid Identity Card or Visitors badge will be required to leave University premises.

An identity Card is issued to each student usually at the time of their first visit to one of the University Learning Centres, providing that a passport-size and style of photograph is produced for inclusion on the Card, together with the enrolment slip. Failure to co-operate in the implementation and continued operation of the Identity Card system shall be regarded as a disciplinary matter and shall be dealt with in accordance with the rules for student discipline.
