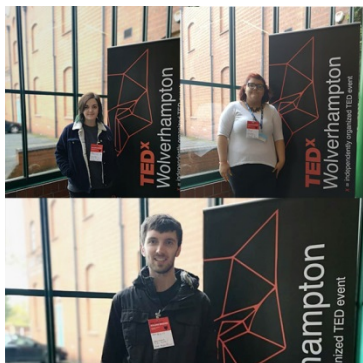

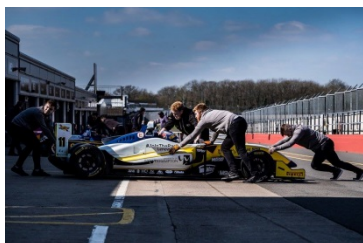

Race Team on track for new season

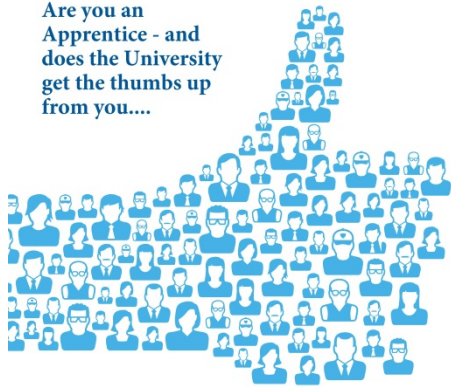
University of Wolverhampton (UWR) Race Team engineering students have [unveiled their 2019 MSVR Formula 3 Cup racing car.](#)
