

Railway station pedestrian subway closure and diversion route



From Sunday, May 20, 2018, the pedestrian subway at Wolverhampton Railway Station will be closed until summer 2019. This is to enable demolition of the current station building and a new one to be built adjacent to it.

A temporary diversion route will be put in place for customers wanting to access the station via Wednesfield Road (see map overleaf).

Wolverhampton Railway Station services will remain fully operational throughout the works.

The redevelopment of the railway station is part of the £150 million City of Wolverhampton Interchange improvements scheme, and the state-of-the-art design means the subway will bring customers directly into the heart of the new station building, which it does not currently do.
