The Tuition Fee for all courses is payable on an annual basis and subject to an inflationary increase in every year.

In such cases the outputs from these materials may be retained by the student.]</i></p> <p><u>Optional</u> field trips and enhancement activities for personal development.</p> <p>Travel costs to and from placements.</p> <p>The cost of any Criminal Records Bureau Check or Occupational Health Assessment where these are required either by the University or a placement provider.</p> <p>Printing & Photocopying. Library Fees and Fines. Own purchase Text Books.</p>
